The manufacturers of Pyroclassic Fires state that any flue system manufactured in accordance to AS/NZ 2918-2001 and tested to Appendix F may be installed on their fires.

Typical examples of flue suppliers are: SPF, Foley Industries, Jayline, Davins etc. These companies all supply tested and approved flue systems.

Both the Pyroclassic IV and the Pyroclassic Mini (with or without wetbacks) are able to utilise these flue systems.

The Pyroclassic fire has been tested and certified to all NZ standards as a fire only. The testing of our fires is done totally independently of any flue component.

Flue suppliers submit flue systems for testing as a separate standalone unit. As long as the flue complies, it will be able to be used on any manufacturers' fire.

When applying for a Building Consent through the relevant Council, any tested flue will be able to be installed on a Pyroclassic fire.

(*** Suitable flue shielding or wall screening will still need to be installed according to Pyroclassic Fires installation specifications.)
